## Intarsie I fabi architekten bda Regensburg I Germany I 2015

The tension between historical heritage and current presence determines the design for the renovation and new building extension. In order not to weaken the stock house in its standalone total term the gap between stock and new construction was covered with a mirror surface. This creates a strong separation of the two buildings. On the entry level, the adjoining streetview is reflected, - rear itself reflects the green of the garden. The new building rests as a simple wooden box cautious but confident next to the inventory. The facade of horizontal untreated oak boards is accentuated by the different board widths. As a kind of inlaid overlap the structures the square window. The oak of the facade of the new contracts also thematically into the interior. The draft recessed furniture characterizes the ground plan from the beginning strongly, as these are the areas specified in the new building.
