This house sensitively integrates into the landscape and the hillside plot and interacts with the terrain in a resource-conserving manner. The upper floor is the entrance and living level. It is shaped as a spacious, airy gabled roof structure clad in wood sheathing, which cantilevers over the garden level below. It faces the panoramic backdrop of the Kampenwand mountain peak and the Chiemgau Alps. Large window openings bring the view directly into the house. This effect is further enhanced by a loggia cutout, which is extended by a cantilevered platform. The single-flight staircase on the slope side receives daylight through an air space all the way down. The lower garden level is set off in dark gray in the façade and forms a quiet, comfortable background for the garden terrace, as well as a covered open space.
